A 58 year old female, white (Not Hispanic or Latino) experienced a non-serious event of anaphylaxis. Her medical history included Type II diabetes, asthma, depression, hypertension, GERD, intermittent colitis and allergy to shellfish. Concomitant medications include fexofenadine, lansoprazole, cimetidine, famotidine, lisinopril, cefdinir and epinephrine auto-injector. On 07 Aug 2020, the participant received the first dose of study medication with normal vital signs documented after administration. On 05 Sep 2020 the participant received the second dose of study medication. An adverse event of sinus infection for which cefdinir was given was reported on 29 Sept 2020 and the outcome is unknown. Approximately 60 days after the second dose on 07 Nov 2020, the participant experienced the event of anaphylaxis which resolved the same day. The event was assessed as moderate in severity, not serious and not related by the study investigator and no action was taken.
